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# Universal/Standard Precautions

Universal/Standard Precautions are a set of infection control practices that healthcare personnel use to reduce transmission of microorganisms in healthcare settings.

## Hand Hygiene

Hand Hygiene has been frequently cited as the single most important practice to help reduce the transmission of infectious agents in the healthcare setting, and is an essential element of Standard Precautions that includes both hand washing with plain or antiseptic-containing soap and water, and use of alcohol-based products that do not require use of water.

### Instant Hand Sanitizers

In addition to traditional hand washing with soap and water, the CDC recommends the use of alcohol-based hand rubs by healthcare personnel as they help address infection prevention needs during resident and patient care interactions.

## Universal/Standard Precautions Cont'd

### Lotion Soaps

The CDC recommends washing hands with non-antimicrobial soap and water or with antimicrobial soap and water if contact with spores (e.g. *C.difficile* or *Bacillus anthracis*) is likely to have occurred.

#### When should I practice hand hygiene?

1. Whenever hands are visibly dirty or contaminated.
2. Before:
  - Having contact with residents and patients
  - Putting on gloves
  - Inserting any invasive device
  - Manipulating an invasive device
2. After:
  - Having contact with residents' or patients' skin
  - Having contact with bodily fluids or excretions, non-intact skin, wound dressings or contaminated items
  - Having contact with inanimate objects near a resident or patient
  - Removing gloves



## Personal Protective Equipment

Personal protective equipment (PPE) refers to a variety of barriers and respirators used alone or in combination to protect mucous membranes, airways, skin and clothing from contact with infectious agents. PPE typically includes gloves, masks and gowns.

### Exam Gloves

Gloves reduce hand contamination by 70-80 percent, preventing cross-contamination and protecting residents, patients and healthcare personnel from infection. Gloves should be changed before and after each resident or patient. It's important to note that the use of gloves does not eliminate the need for hand hygiene. Both techniques should be used together to be most effective.

## Universal/Standard Precautions Cont'd

### Apparel

Isolation gowns are used as specified by Standard and Transmission-Based Precautions, to protect the healthcare workers' arms and exposed body areas and prevent contamination of clothing with blood, body fluids and other potentially infectious material. If fluid penetration is likely, a fluid resistant gown should be used.

## Headwear & Footwear

It is recommended to wear PPE when the nature of the anticipated resident or patient interaction indicates that contact with blood or body fluids may occur. It is also recommended to prevent contamination of clothing and skin during the process of removing PPE.

## Masks, Goggles & Shields

Masks are used for three primary purposes in healthcare settings:

- 1) Placed on healthcare personnel to protect them from contact with infectious material from residents or patients (e.g. respiratory secretions and sprays of blood or body fluids, consistent with Standard Precautions and Droplet Precautions)
- 2) Placed on healthcare personnel when engaged with infectious agents carried in a healthcare worker's mouth or nose
- 3) Placed on coughing residents or patients to limit potential dissemination of infectious respiratory secretions from the resident or patient to others (i.e. Respiratory Hygiene/Cough Etiquette).

Masks may be used in combination with goggles to provide more complete protection for the face.

## Universal/Standard Precautions Cont'd

### Respirators

The CDC currently recommends N95 or higher level respirators for personnel exposed to residents or patients with suspected or confirmed tuberculosis as well as other diseases that could be transmitted through the airborne route, including SARS and smallpox. Respirators are also currently recommended to be worn during the performance of aerosol-generating procedures (e.g. intubation, bronchoscopy and suctioning).

## Environmental Disinfection

Cleaning and disinfecting non-critical surfaces in resident and patient care areas is a critical component of infection prevention in healthcare facilities. It's important to establish policies and procedures for containing, transporting and handling resident- and patient-care equipment and instrument devices that may be contaminated with blood or body fluids. Medical equipment, instruments and devices must be cleaned and maintained according to manufacturers' instructions to prevent transmission of infectious agents.

### Surface Disinfection

The CDC recommends establishing policies and procedures for routine and targeted cleaning of environmental surfaces as indicated by the level of resident or patient contact and degree of soiling. Select EPA-registered disinfectants or detergents that best meet the overall needs of your facility for routine cleaning and disinfection.

- Primary breaches in infection control practice:
  - Reinsertion of used needles into multi-dose vial or solution container (e.g., saline bag).
  - Use of a single needle/syringe to administer intravenous medication to multiple residents or patients.

- Needle cannulas and syringes are sterile single-use items; they should not be reused for another resident or patient or to access a medication or solution that may be used for subsequent residents or patients.



- Consider a syringe or needle/cannula contaminated once it has been used to enter or connect to a resident or patient intravenous infusion bag or admin set.

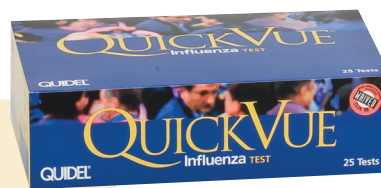

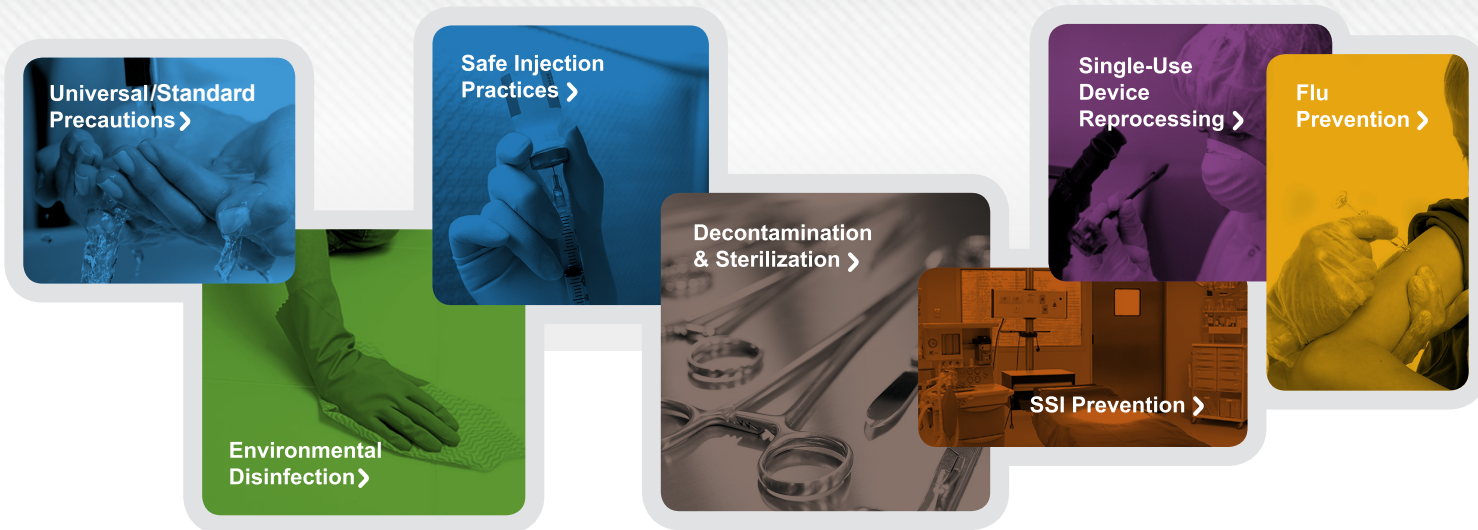
